An application moved by the IO seeking **05 days** PC remand of accused Navneet Kalra. Accused Naveen has been arrested for offences alleged U/S 3/7 Essential Commodities Act, Section 3 Epidemic Diseases Act & 420/188/120B/34 IPC. Accused has been alleged of indulging in black marketing of oxygen concentrators and other COVID 19 treatment related equipments at very high price to needy victims. The quality of the recovered O.C's has been found to be below prescribed standards. Accused Navneet has been arrested in this case today itself. Out of 748 O.C's only 137 have been recovered so far.


All the concerned parties heard.

The court is of the view that custodial interrogation of the accused is required for recovery of electronic devices, used for the purpose of commission of alleged offences, to recover the remaining O.C's, to identify the other victims, exploited by him, for detailed investigation regarding his involvement and connections with M/s Matrix and Classic Metals, the manner of procurement of O.C's, for detailed investigation of financial transactions from his firm as well as to identify the other co-accused/ associates involved in the present case.

Considering the above said grounds, **03 day** PC remand of accused person is granted.

Accused be medically examined before production as per rule and be produced on 20.05.2021 before concerned Duty MM.

A copy of this order be given to the IO, to the Ld. Counsel for the accused as well as to the Ld. APP, if requested.
